Long term economic development gets achieved through locally driven technological and social innovations. KeNIA has set an ambitious goal of creating over 5 million new jobs over the next 5-year strategic plan period, by nurturing startups that emerge from innovative ideas by students, youth, researchers, faculty, and the public. This will be done through scouting ideas particularly in the national priority sectors of Agriculture, Technology, Food security, Healthcare and Clean energy, and then collaboratively supporting them as they grow into scalable enterprises. Through the programs coordinated by KeNIA in partnership with other stakeholders, we will ensure intellectual property is protected and incubation programs are effective.

In the course of 2023, KeNIA has lined up several initiatives among them being:

1. Developing a 10-year national innovation masterplan to support coordination and prioritization of innovation efforts and hence capitalize on our collective national strengths.
2. Operationalizing the coordination framework for innovation hubs across the country, to help effectively support the hubs and track the outputs in a structured manner.
3. Implementing the national commercialization guidelines to support commercialization and technology transfer efforts of Universities, TVETs and Research Centres. This increases creation of alternative forms of income for our institutions, enhancement of the impact of research and ideas as well as creation of new enterprises.
4. Designing and rolling out a national innovation challenge to catalyze discoverability of innovative solutions from the grassroots and exploring practical mechanisms of nurturing them for the national good.
5. Designing a national innovation fund that would make it possible for private sector to complement Government agenda in funding promising startups who have the potential to scale and create numerous jobs in society.

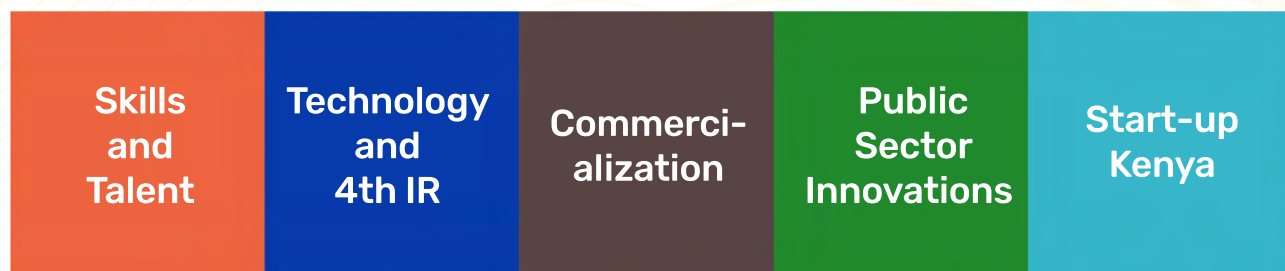

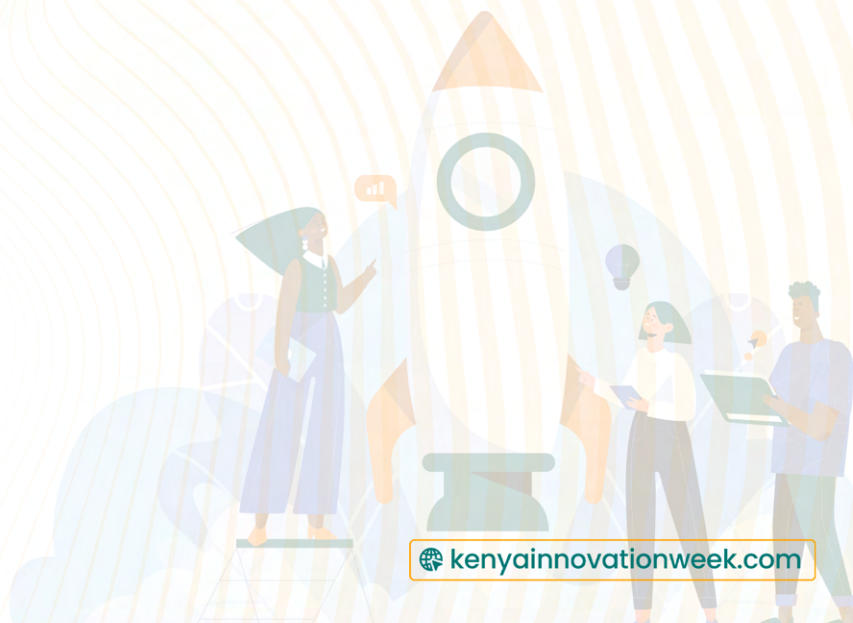

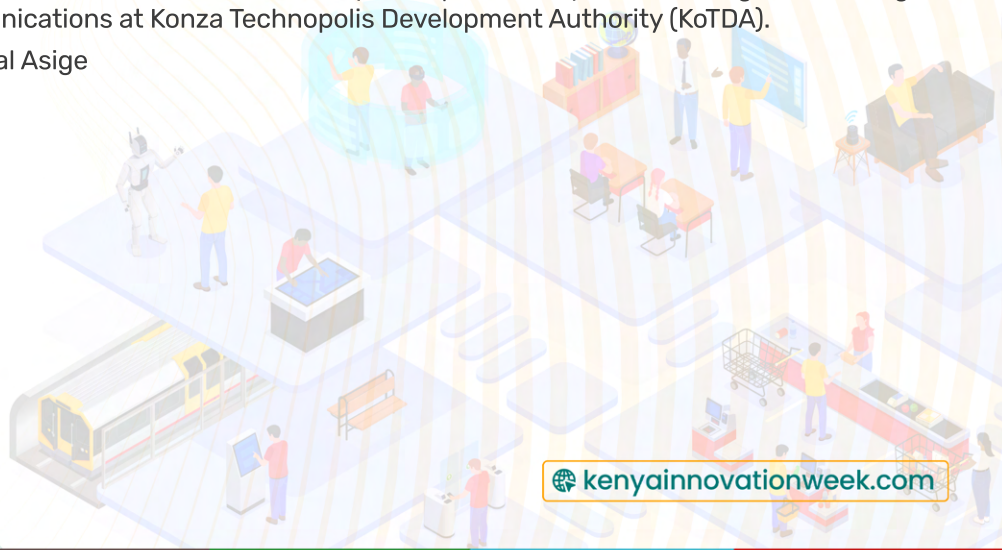
